<p>Literature Review and Theory</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Summarize and integrate results of prior literature • Motivate inclusion of variables in paper • Discuss how current paper fits into literature or builds on current literature • Correct citation use and style 	10
<p>Data and Summary Statistics</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discuss data source and sample selection • Describe variables and present summary statistics in an easy-to-read table • Do summary statistics make sense? Discuss unexpected signs or irregularities/problems with data 	20
<p>Empirical Results/Discussion</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Present model to be estimated, including estimation method (regression, panel data method, probit/logit, etc...) • Present model results in an easy-to-read table • Address important econometric problems (e.g. heteroskedasticity, serial correlation, endogeneity, omitted variables, irrelevant variables, etc...) • Discuss and interpret key variable(s) of interest including hypothesis test and economic importance • Compare results to previous work discussed in literature review • Answer the research question 	20
<p>Conclusion</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Summary of paper • Any limitations? • Extensions for future work • Policy Implications or applications of results 	10
